

LES DEUX FRÈRES

Les Deux Frères is our unique interpretation of what Paso Robles' terroir has to offer. By blending the beautiful characteristics of both Spanish style and Paso personality, this wine is focused on purity and pleasure. Grenache brings brightness with earth and minerality, while the Cabernet Sauvignon & Tempranillo bring a darkness, spice and tannin structure. In its youth, Les Deux Frères has expressive structure and darker red fruits, but with age the spices and tannins will soften to a warm rich wine characterized by a long finish.

TASTING NOTES AT TIME OF RELEASE

Pouring bright red in the glass, 2020 Les Deux Frères has a truly enchanting bouquet of baked fall spices and charred spice wood. The rich, warming aromas of molasses and dark jam combine to create the scent of freshly baked black cherry coulis. Vanilla and cacao with dark spice, cherry tartlet and a dash of nuttiness and umami show on the palate. An elegant and velvety texture complement this approachable and expressive Grenache-based wine.
