This wine is characterized by a meticulous approach to Cabernet Sauvignon grown in Paso. An elegant Bordeaux style with minerally driven tannins and an opulent finish, Origin's refined and enchanting aromas never cease to enliven the senses and captivate the drinker.

TASTING NOTES AT TIME OF RELEASE

A pure Cabernet Sauvignon paying tribute to Bordeaux while still honoring its Paso fruit, Origin 2020 has a nose reminiscent of toasted cedar bark, blueberry tartlet and rich ink. Wild raspberries and crushed blueberries fold into this indulgent wine. Red fruit, licorice, oak and hints of vanilla all emerge from this beauty as tannins warm up an air of baking spice before a balanced minerally driven finish encompasses the palate.
