## O R I G I N

Deep rooted in the clay and limestone of the west side, this polished expression of the nascent Paso Robles terroir is extraordinary. This wine is characterized by a meticulous approach to Cabernet Sauvignon grown in Paso. An elegant Bordeaux style with mineral-driven tannins and an opulent finish, Origin's refined and enchanting aromas never cease to enliven the senses and captivate the drinker.

### TASTING NOTES AT TIME OF RELEASE

A refined, textured wine, Origin 2021's deep burgundy radiates in the glass. The nose is teased by cherry vanilla, licorice, and cola. Coffee cake with a dark cedar and floral fragrance fill the glass with a soft aroma. The wine is elegant and structured with round, polished and silky tannins expressing the longevity of aging potential. Chocolate cherry and cassis swirl together on the palate with a long, drawn-out finish hinting at sun baked river stones, dried green herbs and Adzuki red bean paste.
